- Individual 10' x 10' display booths plus, final set-up of dealer display material on Friday morning.

- All display vehicles must be removed from the arena by 9:00 P.M. Sunday evening. Display vehicles will be allowed to park overnight in the side parking lot. This lot will be patrolled until 12 noon Monday, January 30, 2012.

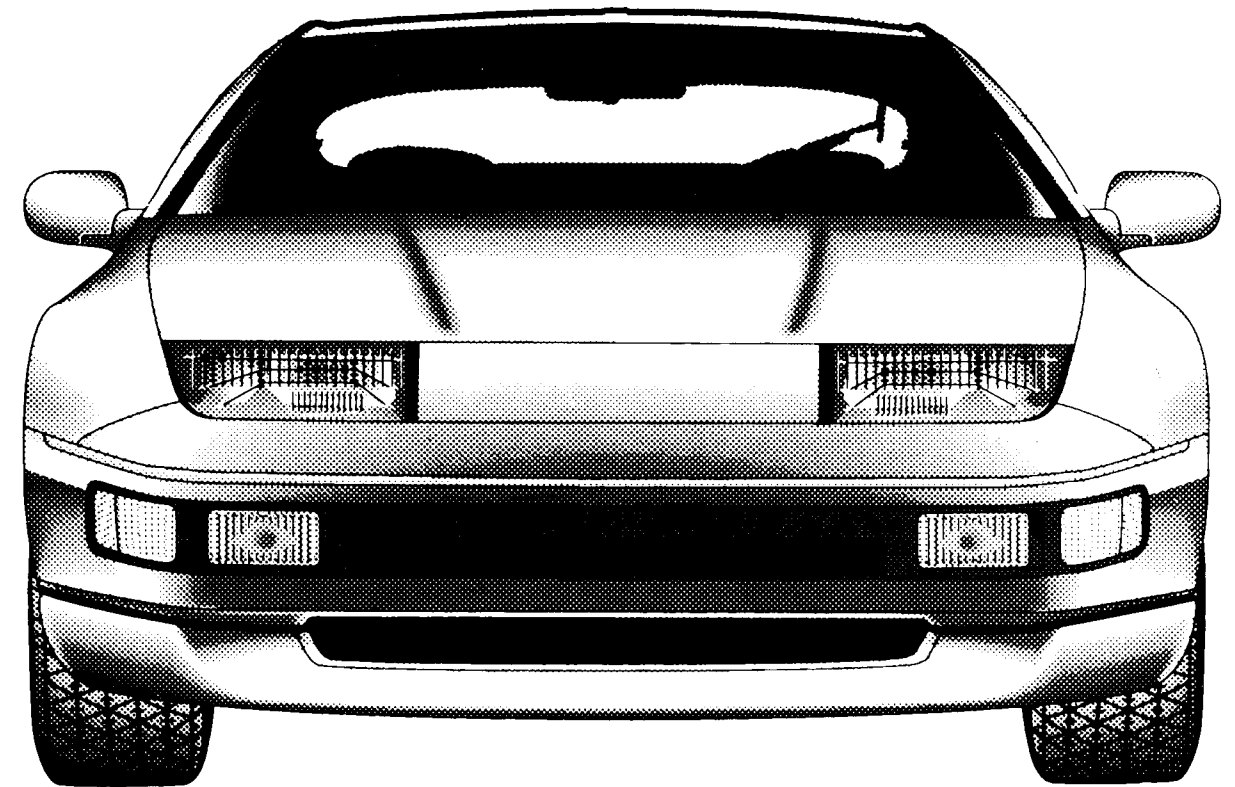

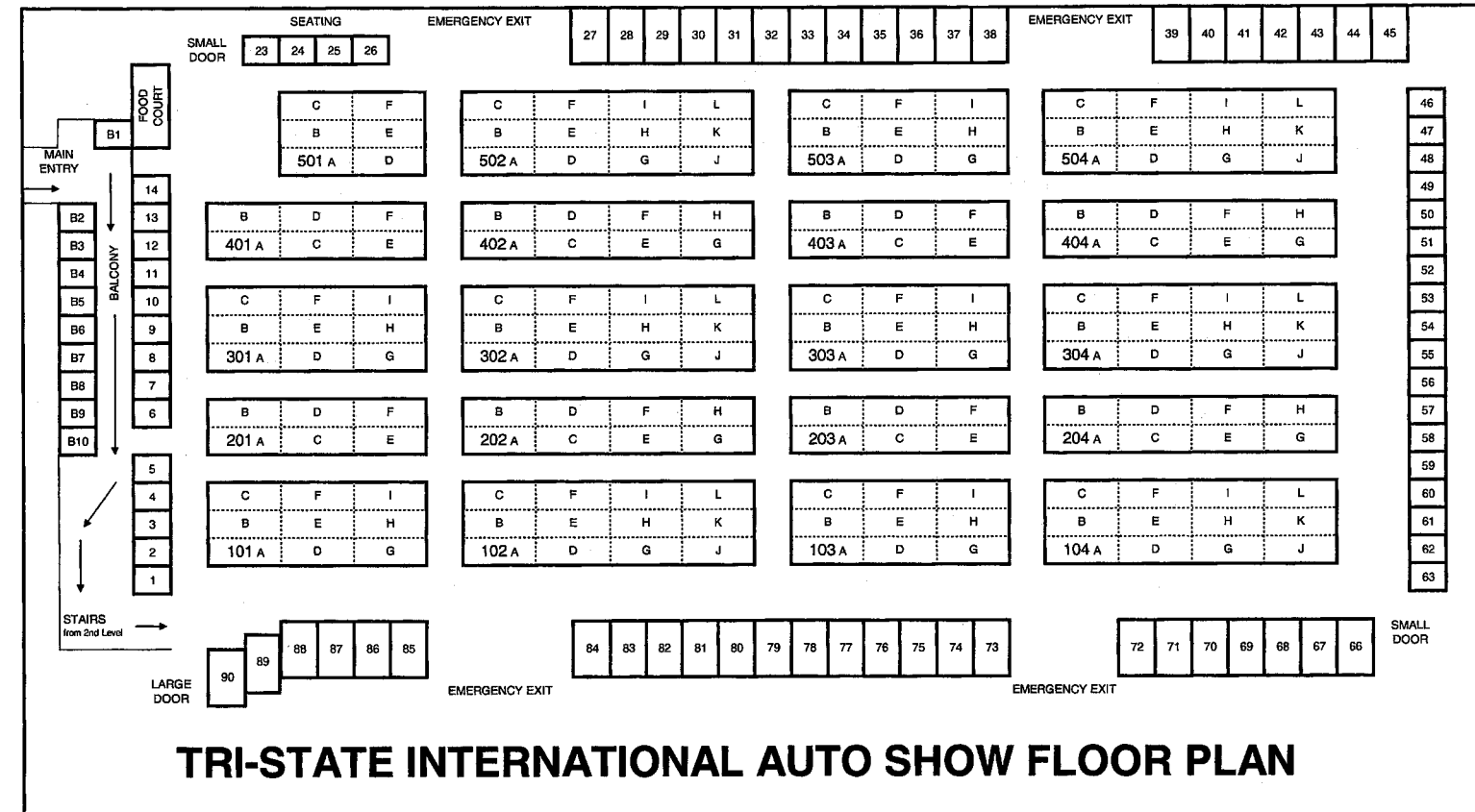

SUFFERN, N.Y. NORTHEAST CROSSROADS

The Rockland Community College is located on College Road, off Route 59 between Suffern and Spring Valley, N.Y. It is also off Interstate 95 and 287 - end of the New Jersey Parkway connecting N.J. Turnpike and Interstate 80. New York Thruway Exit 14B Airmont Road.

NO UNION RESTRICTIONS

Unlike most other possible show facilities, the Rockland Arena will allow exhibitors to unload their exhibit material themselves and to erect their own displays. Management will have an official show decorator firm available for those who wish to rent booth furnishings. This option is solely at the choice of the exhibitor.

RCC INDOOR ARENA BEST BUILDING

The Rockland Community College Arena is a 90,000 square foot heated, lighted comfort-controlled indoor building where everyone parks free. There are no pillars or obstruction on the arena floor. Easy access in and out of the building by way of overhead doors. Every exhibitor is in the same room.
